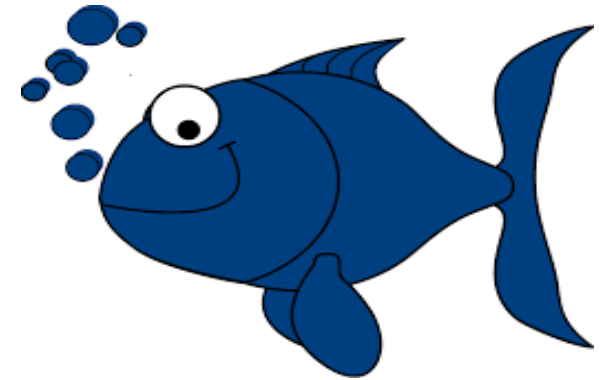

Service Provided

FISH
(Friends In Service Here)

FISH is a volunteer organization that provides transportation to medical appointments for individuals unable to drive themselves, or unable to arrange other transportation.

There are times when FISH Services may not be able to meet all requests for rides since the number of our volunteers is limited. We ask you to use the FISH Service only if you have no other means of transportation.

A volunteer driver will contact you to confirm the time and location for your pick-up and drop-off within three business days of your scheduled doctor's appointment. If you have special needs, please inform the FISH dispatcher.

Volunteer drivers are equipped to provide transportation for the ambulatory only and are not able to provide medical care. Please call the FISH Dispatcher with any cancellations or rescheduling concerns as soon as you become aware of them.

Transportation is provided to medical appointments only. If needed, please bring your handicap parking tag. You will be responsible for any and all parking fees while being assisted to your medical appointment.
