The following is a report for the Big Brothers Big Sisters program activities for the month of November 2017:

we received tickets to SU basketball games and passed them on to "bigs" and who took "littles" to game

- we met with Pat Driscoll, Executive Director of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Syracuse, to discuss possible collaboration in which our "bigs" could meet their "littles" at local Boys & Girls Club venues and take advantage of their facilities

- Community Based Case Manager Sadequa Fore completed her CPR Training

- Sharon Thompson and our staff came to a decision on the Bowl for Kids' Sake promo designs (which were created by Cazenovia College School of Fashion & Design students as a part of their Fall project)

- Sadequa kicked off our BNY Mellon Corporate based program - 14 Bigs and 11 Littles.

- Sadequa also started the new school based partnership with Bishop Grimes and Blessed Sacrament. 8 Bigs, 6 Littles.

- staff met with Renshi Carlos Tierney, a World Class Karate Champion, about incorporating his workshops (self-esteem, emotional health, making wise choices, anti-bullying, etc.) into school based and corporate based programming.

- holiday party at Bishop Ludden was on Sun 12/3, Over 60 "littles" (current and waiting list) and 30 "bigs" attended. Volunteers included the Syracuse Silver Knights, Bishop Ludden's boys' soccer team, several Bishop Ludden "bigs", Peace Staffers Carolyn Brown, Sharon Thompson, Jessica Ponti. Food Services (Randy Lamanche) served up a delicious meal.
