## Center-Based:

- Classroom setting
- Full and half day programs
- Limited transportation provided
- Nutritious meals served

## Home-Based (ages 0-5):

Programs for pregnant women, infants, toddlers and pre-schoolers.

## All Programs Provide:

High quality individualized educational programming to prepare children and families for kindergarten.

## Head Start (HS)

3-5 years of age
