**Syracuse City School District 2015-2016 Contract**

Contract signed with SCSD for \$350,000 for 15-16 school year.

\$ 269,000 (77% of grant) to cover volunteer stipends\*, volunteer travel, volunteer meals, recognition, uniforms and insurance.

(\* \$232,428 for stipends for 84 foster grandparent volunteer)

\$ 80,333 (23%) to cover 1.5 salaries & fringe, indirect, staff travel, office supplies and professional & liability insurance.
